Objective:

Develop a secure, cloud-based application that leverages **Biometrics Authentication** to elevate user security.

Things to consider:

- Usage of biometrics to authenticate users for securing identity verification
- Design an intuitive registration and authentication process that emphasizes user-friendliness
- Implement data security measure to protect biometric data
- a comprehensive, fully integrated solution to demonstrate complete end-to-end flow

Challenge:

Integrate biometric authentication into a **real-world scenario** where it significantly enhances value or transforms the user experience. Explore creative ways to **extend** the use of biometric data beyond authentication.
